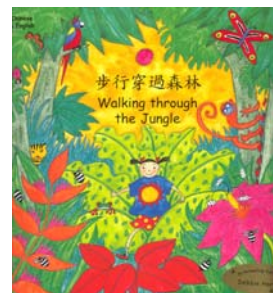

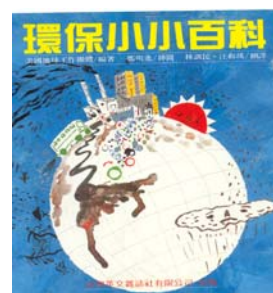


**Title:** 50 Simple Things Kids Can Do to Save the Earth
