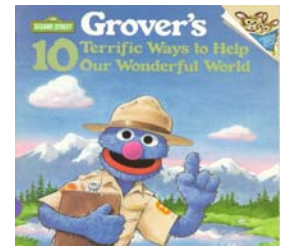


**Title:** Grover's 10 Terrific Ways to Help Our Wonderful World

**Title:** Dinosaurs to the Rescue! A Guide to Protecting Our Planet

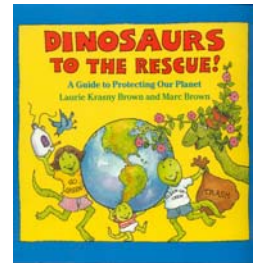
**Author:** Laurie Krasny Brown

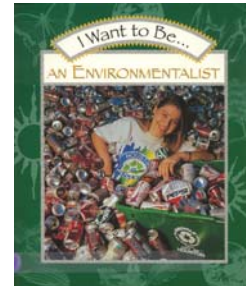


**Title:** I Want to be an Environmentalist

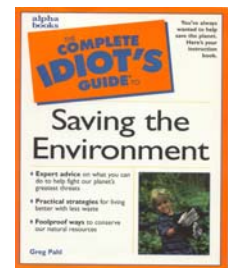


**Title:** The Complete Idiot's Guide to Saving the Environment

**Grade:** 7-12

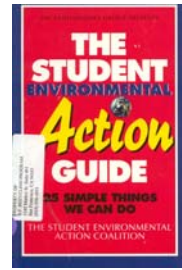

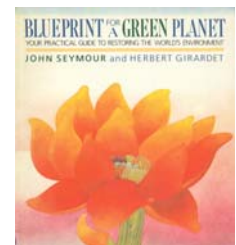

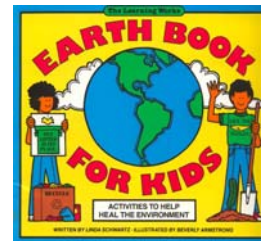
**Summary:** This book describes the many ways individuals and communities can halt and reverse massive environmental damage such as deforestation, acid rain, air pollution and toxic waste.

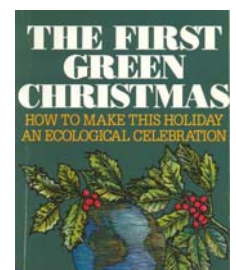

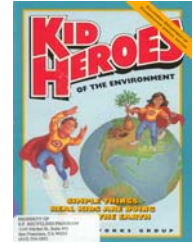

**Summary:** This informational booklet describes many different ways to help the Earth. Includes issues such as deforestation, toxics, and recycling.



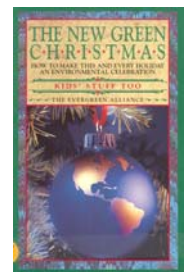

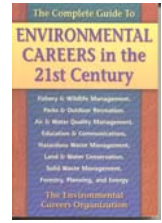


**Title:** The Complete Guide to Environmental Careers in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century
