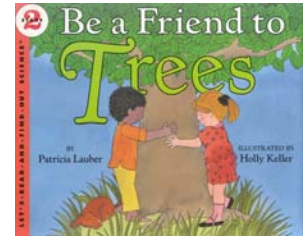

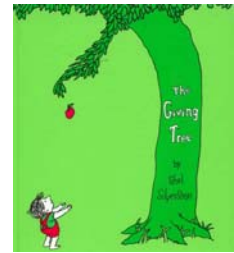


Title: The Giving Tree

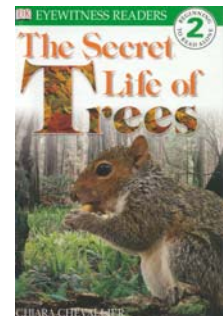

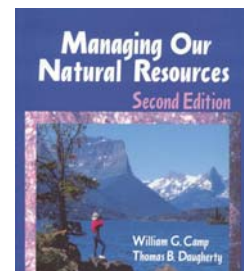


Title: Managing Our Natural Resources

Summary: This book offers the viewpoints of preservationists, environmentalists, and industry regarding the use and management of resources like land, water, forests, and minerals.

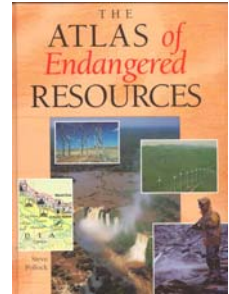


Title: The Atlas of Endangered Resources

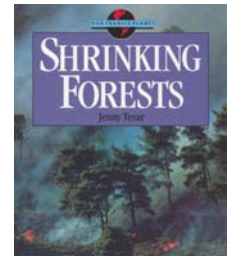


Title: Shrinking Forests
