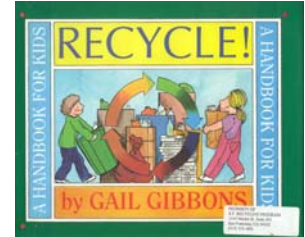

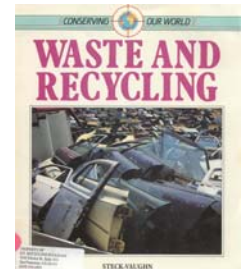

**Summary:** This illustrated book examines global issues concerning people and the environment. It not only explains the threats posed to our fragile planet, but also the international measures taken to preserve it.

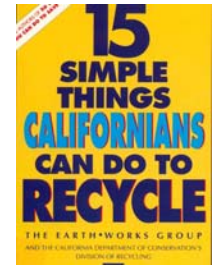


**Title:** 15 Simple Things Californians Can Do to Recycle
